Whereas one member has to be elected from among the Medical Practitioners of Madhya Pradesh to the Medical Council of India under section 3 (1) (C) of the Indian Medical Association 1956, I Dr. K. K. Thassu, the Returning Officer, request all the Medical Practitioners who are registered with either (i) Mahakoshal Medical Council or (ii) Medical Council (Government) Bhopal or (iii) Madhya Pradesh Medical Council in the category of Medical Graduates of Indian or the recognized Foreign Universities . Medical Institutions, whose Medical Qualifications are included in the First or Second or in Part II of the Third Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 **and practicing in State of Madhya Pradesh to stand as candidate for the Election or to Elect a Member from among them.**

Copies of the Electoral Roll are available in the office of Madhya Pradesh Medical Council, F-7, Sanchi Complex, Bhopal and shall be open for inspection during office hours in working days. The Electoral Rolls can also be seen on M. P. Medical Council website < www.mpmedicalcouncil.net>.

Any person registered among Graduates of Indian or recognized Foreign Universities, whose qualification are included in the First or Second or in part II or Third Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act 1956, can be nominated as a candidate for Election. **As per Rule No. 11 of Indian Medical Council Rules 1957, such nomination are to be made in Form No. I, which shall be supplied by the Returning Officer on request in writing .**

Accordingly, I Dr. K. K. Thassu, Returning Officer for election to the Medical Council of India, by exercising powers vested under Rule 10 of Indian Medical Council Rules 1957, hereby notify the election schedule for the election of one member to the Medical Council of India to represent the constituency of Registered Medical Practitioners of the State of Madhya Pradesh under section 3(1)(c) of IMC Act 1956 as follows :-

7.	Declaration of Result	18.03.2015 (Wednesday) immediately after counting


For the convenience of the Registered Medical Practitioners the Rule 12(1) of the Rules 1957, under the heading Nomination Paper are reproduced below:

" Each nomination paper shall be subscribed by two electors as proposer and seconder;

Provided that no elector shall subscribe more nomination than one

Provided further that if more than one nomination paper be subscribed by the same elector, the nomination paper first received by the Retuning Officer shall, if otherwise in order, be held to be valid and if more than one nomination paper signed by the same elector be received simultaneously by the Returning Officer, all such nomination papers shall be held to be invalid."

The Nominated candidate or their duly authorized representative may attend the process of scrutiny of nomination paper and counting of votes."
