**Subject:** Reconstitution of Medical Council of India - reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No.MPMC/Election (MCI)/2014/5622 dated 24.09.2014 and No. MPMC/Election (MCI)/2014/6185 dated 29.10.2014 on the subject noted above and to say that as per Section 28 of the Indian Medical Council (IMC) Act, 1956, every person registered in the Indian Medical Register shall notify any transfer of the place of his residence or practice to the Council and to the State Medical Council concerned, within thirty days of such transfer, failing which is right to participate in the election of members to the Council or a State Medical Council shall be liable to be forfeited by order of the Central Government either permanently or for such period as may be specified therein.

2. It is, therefore, requested that all such persons/doctors who have not complied the section 28 of IMC Act, 1956 are not eligible to participate in the forthcoming election, in any form to be held to elect a Member, MCI to represent the constituency of Registered Medical Practitioner of the State of Madhya Pradesh under section 3 (1) (c) of IMC Act, 1956.
